The total cost of training through the modular route, including flying hours is generally between £45,000-£65,000. This compares favourably with the integrated route where the costs of training to the same point are typically more like £95,000 or over.

The member schools listed are only an example. Normally we would recommend pilots do the majority of their flight training at one or two schools and their PPL at their local flying centre.
