The total cost of our modular training programme, including flying hours is generally between £50,000-£65,000. This compares favourably with the integrated route where the costs of training to the same point are typically more like £100,000 or over. Travel is excluded from the above costs as it will vary depending on the location of your flight schools.

The member schools listed are only an example. Normally we would recommend pilots do the majority of their flight training at one or two schools.
